PROGRESS CONTINUES WITH TRANSITION

Thank you to all of the schools that have been demo-ing the Injury Surveillance Tool. Your experience and feedback has been enormously helpful. As a result of this activity, we have become aware that a small number of schools have had a problem using the tool due to their institution's network and firewall configurations.

The current Tool was designed in an application that requires the ATs to download

software on to their local computers. This software manages communications between the local computer and a remote database where all of the information is stored and managed. This architecture was chosen specifically to accommodate desired features and work flow enhancements that are more difficult through a web portal application.

However, in order to ensure universal availability, the Datalys

Center will be launching a pure web-based injury surveillance tool in late July. This tool will be similar to the current beta injury surveillance tool that folks have been working with throughout the spring. It will contain the same functionality (roster, calendar, injuries, injury case printing), but it will be web-based and include a handful of additional refinements that have been identified over the past few months.
