INJURY SURVEILLANCE TOOL UPDATE

The Datalys Center will be releasing new updates on the Injury Surveillance Tool in June.

Calendar update: Each user will have the ability to set a default calendar view (day, week or month). When you enter the IST, the calendar will open to your preference. While working within the calendar the IST will now save the last view you were in. For example, if you are setting up September 2010 monthly calendar, and navigate away, and click on calendar again it will bring you to the monthly view of

September 2010. Logging out will set the calendar back to the current day, week, or month depending on your user preference. The calendar will also be redesigned to display Sunday-Saturday to be consistent with the drop down calendars throughout the system.

Report Generator: The functionality to create Exposure, Team and Individual reports will be added. You will have the ability to create reports on your athlete's information as an end of the year summary.

Class year rollover: July 1, 2010 all athletes will automatically be rolled to the next class year. (E.g. Freshman to Sophomore, Sophomore to Junior, etc). All athletes classified as Seniors or Fifth Years will roll to **. These athletes will be removed from Injury Search functions. You will need to edit any seniors who are staying on as 5th Years to reclassify them and make them available for the Injury Search.
