Timeline for Research Data Release*

- **August 6, 2010:**

Begin posting codebooks (data definitions); data not contained within the codebooks is not available. Additional codebooks will be uploaded as they become available.

Application information available for data release requests.

- **September 1, 2010:**

Begin accepting requests and review by Independent Review Committee (IRC).

- **October 1, 2010:**

Begin NCAA review and authorization of individual data release requests.

- **November 1, 2010:**

Begin dataset preparation of approved research requests.

- **November 30, 2010**

Begin dataset dissemination for approved requests.

*Note: Research Data refers to de-identified non-aggregated data, which the Datalys Center provides for research purposes. Requests for data will be reviewed by the IRC and the NCAA, with the NCAA authorizing data release based on the individual requests.

The IRC will meet monthly to review data requests. On an on-going basis, the data request and release cycle is anticipated to take 60 to 90 days depending on when a request is submitted relative to the next scheduled IRC meeting. Expedited request and review is not available at this time.

Aggregated summary data will be made available during the fall of 2010 through the Datalys Center Document Library.
